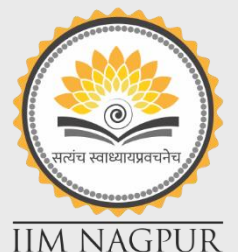

Participants: The conference is open for all interested parties to participate in person or watch the conference online.

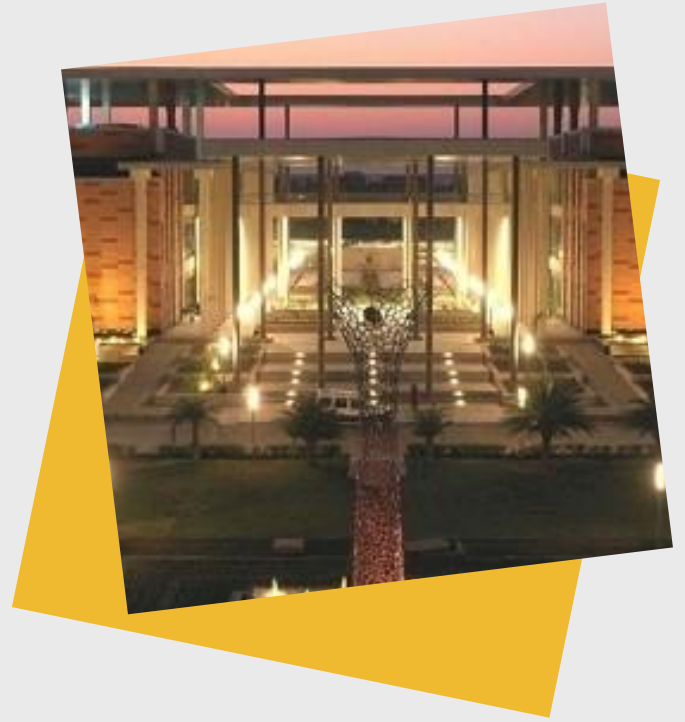
Location: The conference will take place on the campus of Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Nagpur in Nagpur, India.
