Location: Various locations in India including Agra, Bengaluru, Goa, Greater Noida, Mumbai and Nagpur.

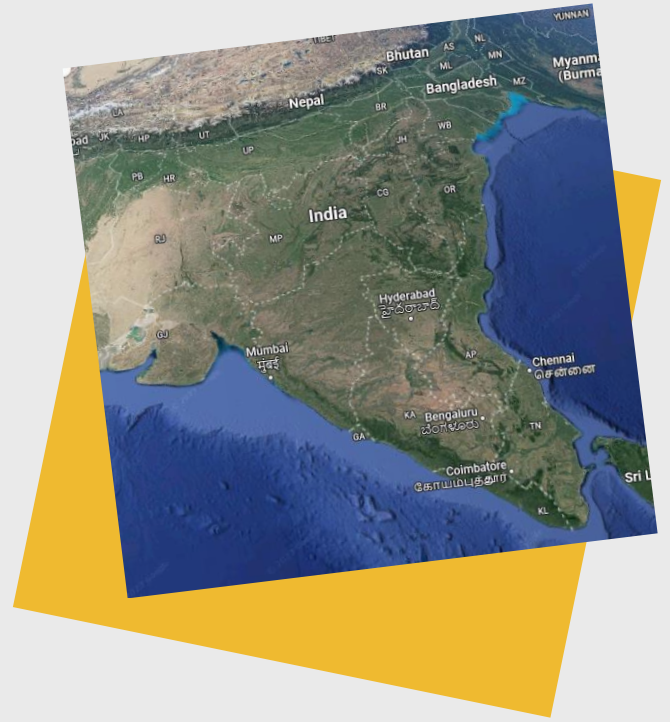
Activities: A blend of conference, roundtables and speaker engagements at Indian business schools combined with cultural activities and some sightseeing.
