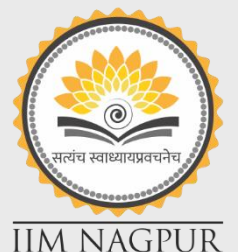

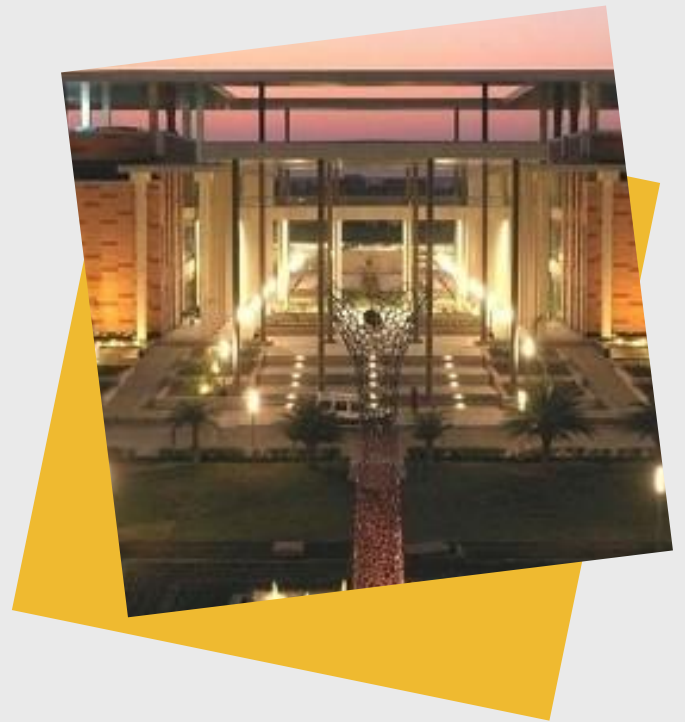
Participants: The conference is open for all interested parties to participate in person or watch the conference online.

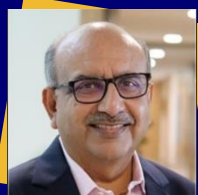
